Scholarship Overview

The Harvey L. Foster Foundation for Science Education will award one or more scholarships for the 2018-2019 academic year of up to \$2000 to deserving students. The scholarship is for one year. Qualifying students are those already enrolled in Southeastern Louisiana University and who are either pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in the field of science, specifically the areas of biology, chemistry, or engineering. This scholarship will be awarded to the top applicant(s) as recommended by the Foundation’s Board of Directors during the Spring of 2019. The scholarship award will be sent directly to Southeastern after enrollment verification for the Fall of 2019.

Mission

The Harvey L. Scholarship Criteria and Application Requirements

The criterion for scholarship candidacy is outlined below:

- **Educational Level.** Must be enrolled at Southeastern Louisiana University.
- **Educational Objective Criteria.** Must pursue a degree in a science or science related engineering field.
- **Enrollment Status.** Must be enrolled full time (12 plus hours) every semester
- **Science Educational Level.** Must have taken a minimum of 15 hours of science and/or engineering classes.
- **Grade Point Average.** Must have a 3.0 cumulative or higher GPA and all science/engineering classes must have a 3.0 or higher GPA.
- **Completed Application.** Required.
- **College Transcript.** Required.
- **Recommendations.** Required. These should be mailed in directly to the Foundation. They include recommendations by two classroom science or engineering professors. Please use the Professor Recommendation Form found on the website.
- **All applications must be submitted to the Foundation no later than January 31, 2019.**
- **Submittal of scholarships.** Application packets can be found on the Foundation's website.
- **Application Format.** Applications must be filled out in Times New Roman font, 12.0 size with file format Microsoft Word or PDF.
